# Student Policy - Phi Theta Kappa - International Honor Society

## **Policy:**

The Bismarck State College Foundation will recognize honor students who are eligible and accept membership into Phi Theta Kappa, the International Honor Society of the Two Year College.

# **Eligibility for Membership:**

- 1. Student must have an institutional grade point average of 3.50 or better to be eligible for membership.
- 2. Students must have completed 12 semester hours of associate degree course work in BSC institutional credits.
- 3. Students must be currently enrolled at BSC as either a part-time or full-time student.
- 4. Students must adhere to the student conduct policy and possess recognized qualities of citizenship.

#### **Induction Process:**

- 1. Early each semester the Phi Theta Kappa advisor(s) shall identify eligible members and hold an orientation meeting. At that time students will have an opportunity to accept membership.
- 2. The BSC Foundation and Phi Theta Kappa advisor(s) shall decide in what manner and at what time the induction of membership will occur.
